Granite PAGE 1

An igneous rock formed from magma deep within the earth's crust, granite is generally composed of quartz and feldspar providing high range hardness. In recent years discoveries of so called 'New Granites' have introduced vibrant and amazing opportunities in colours and patterns, no longer limiting the range in granite to only homogeneous patterns. Extremely scratch resistant, heat resistant and chip resistant with low porosity makes granite an excellent material for both internal and external applications. Ideally suited for kitchen bench tops and flooring, Granite's resistance to all types of weather is also the perfect solution for external cladding. Traditionally finished in a high polish, new technology has produced a recent trend towards textured finishes such as flamed, honed and satin finishes.

Quartzite PAGE 6

Quartzite is a natural stone, not to be confused with Quartz/Engineered stone. Quartzite has similar if not stronger physical-mechanical features than granite. Quartzite is suitable for both internal and external applications depending on the particular type. Quartzite can uniquely offer colours and veining similar to that of marble with the added benefit of the hardness of granite, making this the ideal kitchen benchtop material.

Dolomite PAGE 9

Dolomite is a sedimentary rock made mostly of the mineral dolomite. Dolomites can look similar to marbles as they generally have a similar appearance and mineral composition. Marbles are predominantly consisting of calcium carbonate; whilst Dolomites consist of calcium magnesium carbonate. People in the industry often refer to Dolomite as a "hard marble". The reason for this is that those stones classified as Dolomites are harder wearing than Marble. Dolomites are generally denser stones providing higher scratch resistance and are not as easily etched by acidic substances (e.g., lemon juice) when compared to a typical Marble. Dolomites would sit in between a Marble and Granite on the durability scale. Dolomites tend to come in shades of white to grey/blue. White Fantasy (aka Super White) is a well-known dolomite which has been an extremely popular choice for countertops in recent times. It is important to keep in mind that whilst dolomites tend not to etch as quickly or deeply as a typical Marble does, they can still etch so we recommend that clients select a honed or satin finish, especially for kitchen benchtop applications, as the effects of etching are barely visible on a honed or stain finish Dolomite but can be more visible on a polished finish.

Marble PAGE 11

A metamorphic rock resulting from the metamorphism of limestone formed under immense heat and pressure. The mainly calcite composition is recognised by its characteristic swirls and veins deriving from various mineral impurities originally present as grains or layers in the limestone. Of mid range hardness, marble is ideally suited for bathroom tops, walls and flooring. Marbles uniqueness makes it desirable for kitchen tops, but care and maintenance needs to be a consideration when choosing this stone. Marble is traditionally used internally in a high polished, mirror like finish however is now also appreciated in a variety of finishes such as honed, brushed and sandblasted with a vast range of colours and patterns available.

Onyx PAGE 15

A calcareous material with a very fine grain and many veins running concentrically to one another, the presentation of the stone is largely dependent on its directional cut. This translucent stone is synonymous with luxury living, a widely recognised presence in the homes of the rich and famous, Onyx is often innovatively backlit to add brilliance and extra dimension. Of mid-range hardness, produced in a high polish finish Onyx exposes an eclectic array of colours and patterns of distinct beauty.


Travertine PAGE 16

Quarried from ancient hot mineral springs in exotic lands, Travertine is a banded, more compact form of Limestone, characterised by the many holes and chambers evident through the stone. Travertine varies in colour from dusty white to silver-grey, to gold, coral red and toffee, available in various finishes such as filled, unfilled, honed or polished creating a classy and sophisticated appearance. Current trends have moved towards a honed finish opting for a more untouched 'old world' like appeal. Travertine is suitable for both internal and external applications.


